# **Receiving your Insight Sidekick.**

After signing up for TelNet's Insight service, a network testing and quality monitoring device will be shipped to your site. Delivery usually takes 3-5 business days.

## **Unboxing and preparing your Insight Sidekick**

After opening the packaging for your Sidekick device, you will see all the components that you need to bring your device online.

- (x1) Insight Sidekick
- (x1) USB charging brick
- (x1) MicroUSB charging cable
- (x2) ethernet cable



#### Where to Install a TelNet Sidekick

To get the most out of your sidekick's feature set, you will need to make a minor change to your network equipment. By enabling mirroring on a switch port you will be able to track the SIP registration status of all the devices on your network.



#### **Setting Up the Insight Sidekick**

1. After unboxing your Sidekick plug the microUSB cable into the sidekick and a power source near your Ethernet switch.





2. Plug the provided ethernet cable into an available port on your switch and the WAN port on the Sidekick.



3. Monitor the green and red lights on the front of the sidekick (the side without the power port and network interfaces)

- Booting Up you will see one solid green light during while the device is booting up
- Establishing Connection you will see one solid green light, one blinking green light, and one flashing red light while the device is establishing a connection to the TelNet Insight Service.
- Connected you will see two blinking green lights when the device is successfully connected to the TelNet Insight Service.

#### **Connecting the Mirrored Port to the Sidekick**

Configuring a mirrored port is covered in our Mirrored Port Setup Guide. To connect the mirrored port Connect one end of the ethernet cord into the port on your sidekick labeled "Mirror", and then the other end into the port on your switch that is mirroring VoIP traffic.





#### TelNet Insight Set-up Guide

## **Required IPs and Services**

TelNet's Sidekick device needs to be able to reach out to TelNet's infrastructure to provide you insight into your network's VoIP readiness. This list of IP addresses and ports will need to be accessible by the sidekick from within your network.
